Please find enclosed a copy of the final claim on this project; the original has been sent to our Auditors Rees Pollock, and I hope it can be certified and returned to you within the next month.

As you will see we haven't quite hit target in all our outputs but I would argue that the original outputs set by Steve McIntyre way back in 1995 were very ambitious and that the results so far at the Centre are highly impressive, given that it has only been fully operational since Spring 1998. The beauty of the project is that it will continue to create job and training opportunities for beneficiaries from the assisted area for many years to come. In addition there are a growing number for related projects such as the Lumiere project (ADAPT/Ufl) and the proposed ERDF application for an East London Production Fund that will provide continuing opportunities for training and production linked to the Centre.

As part of our programme of media development within the assisted area we will be talking to Hackney Council and educational providers in the Hoxton area about mapping the growth of media industries. There is no doubt that the Centre and related activity has transformed the face of Hoxton and that there is still room for further growth.
