 Acquisition: Programmos selected for inclusion in the Library will be transforred to the video formet in use in the Library at the expense of the ICA. The ICA will not hire or purchase tapes for the Library.

2. <u>Holding</u> : Programmes will be hold in the Library for a period of two years, which initial period may be renewed at the option of the ICA. This agreement may be terminated by either party by three months notice in writing, such notice not to expire bufore the end of the [irst year.

3. <u>Viowing</u> : The ICA will offer each programme for public viowing during hours of the Library at the rates published in the catalogue.

4. Revelties : Within 28 days of the 31st of March each year the ICA shall

remit to the copyright owner royalities at the rate of 50% of box-office income (less WY at the current rate) derived from the public viewing of each programme in the year up to 31st of March. 5. <u>Copyright</u> : The copyright owner shell retain all rights in the programme except those covered by this agroment and the ICA shell ensure that a

copyright notice appears on the catalogue entry for each programme.

6. Warranty : The producer warrants that s/he is the sole owner of the copyright in the programme and that all other copyright permissions have been pro

against any claim arising out of any breach of such copyright.

7. Promotion : The ICA shall reserve the right of non-paying promotional use of the programme within the ICA.

Ownership : The ICA shall retain ownership of the tapes in the Library.

9. Hire : The video-tapes shall be kept in the Library at the ICA and

will be handled only by Ion staff.
All requests for hiro, purchase or use of the video-tapes for any other
form of broadcast will be re-directed to the copyright owner. The ICA
