Relocation to Hoxton Square

Further to your recent discussion with Chris Chandler I am writing to correct the unfortunate arithmetical error which crept into my letter dated 2nd March 1995, regarding financial support for the Co-op and LEA following relocation to Hoxton Square. The figure for anticipated rent should have read £63,300 (sixty three thousand three hundred pounds) out of a total budget of £85,000 (eighty five thousand pounds). All other conditions in the letter remain accurate.

Also following recent discussions, I am pleased to confirm that, of the money allocated to the Hoxton Square project within the Development Budget in 1995-96, the sum of £10,000 has provisionally been allocated for projects jointly agreed between LFMC and LEA.
